Reading picture books aloud and singing nursery rhymes while interacting with your baby is not only great fun for your baby, but the careful selection of words used in picture books and the beautiful yet succinct traditional Japanese used in nursery rhymes will develop their sense of language.

When babies are still under one year old, it's best to read them picture books that repeat words and have a fun rhythm. When you sing nursery rhymes, try using your fingers to nudge and tickle your baby's face and body.


